BUFFET LINE REMINDERS... These ten suggestions help the hostesses that volunteer to serve you during the meeting: 1) Use plastic bags to **take dirty dishes home.** *We do not have time to wash dishes for you.* 2) **Disposable containers are preferred** as they speed up our cleanup. 3) **Serving forks and spoons are provided,** so we request you don't bring them. 4) **Retrieve non-disposable dishes promptly** after the meeting. 5) Have **your name on carrier, container & lid.** 6) Please **check with us if you're missing a kitchen item.** We have several items that need to find their owner. 7) **Bring food ready to serve.** We are too busy to cut whole chickens, pies, cakes, etc., or to cook your casserole. 8) Food suggestions: **Meats, cold cuts, green salads, fresh fruit, deviled eggs and deli breads are needed** as we often run out of them first. Pasta dishes are often left and desserts are usually plentiful. 9) Don't put candy wrappers, gum or other **items in empty water bottles** and drink what you take. 10) **Place empty bottles toward one end of the table** before you leave so we can recycle.
